

What are we?

We give help to parents/carers of children aged 0-5; pre-owned good condition clothing, shoes, coats; and toiletries: nappies, wipes etc; baby equipment if in stock.

Who do we help?

Those who are currently finding it very difficult to cope with the rising costs of children's essentials: clothing and hygiene products.

Where are we?

We are situated at St John's Orangefield, on the Castlereagh Road. The church halls are immediately behind the church with plenty of room for car parking. We are on bus route Metro 5.

When are we open?

We are open on Friday mornings from 10.00–12.00 for packages to be collected; these must be ordered one week in advance of collection. See contact details overleaf.

How can I apply for help?

Referrals can be made by Midwives, Health Visitors, Pharmacists, Doctors, Care Workers, Family Support, Sure Start and other professionals. Self-referrals can be made on completion of a registration form; you will need someone who will give a reference for you.

What help will be given?

Up to 4 times a year, a care package of age, gender, and seasonally appropriate clothing (underwear, day wear, nightwear, coat & shoes).

Up to 4 times a year, a hygiene package appropriate to the age of the child can be collected (typically with nappies, wipes, cream, toothpaste/brush, shampoo).

Packages will be recorded by date and signature of person receiving them. You can order for all children in your family who are 0-5 years of age once registered.
